What facilities and services do you provide?

Who is the Centre for?

All higher and vocational education students over 18. If you are enrolled in higher or vocational education or exploring your higher and vocational education possibilities you can register with us. After-hours access will be available for registered students.

Interested in further education but not sure where to start? Or if you have not studied for a long time, or you are under 18. You can visit during business hours, once we are open, to find out more about your future study possibilities.

When is the Centre open?

Not yet. We will be ready for you in September 2025! Once we open, we know that your best time for dedicated study might not be during business hours. Once you are registered we will provide you with your own personalised after hours access. Our after hours details are coming soon!

Can you help me get there?

How do I register to use the Centre?

Once we are open you simply fill in our form or drop in to express your interest. We will then complete your registration with you. You need to provide proof of enrolment in a course, photo ID and complete an orientation at the Centre before gaining after hours access. Once registered, you'll receive your personalised access to the Centre 7 days a week.
